

## Cross-Country Schooling at Feather Creek Farm

Norman, Oklahoma

July 30-31<sup>st</sup>, 2010



Road Trip! Stone Ridge is headed south to school Feather Creek Farm's cross-country courses on July 30<sup>th</sup>. We will stable overnight and head home on Saturday, July 31<sup>st</sup>. It is approximately a 4 1/2 hour drive.

Feather Creek Farm offers Starter (18") through Preliminary (3'7") cross-country courses nestled within a grove of trees on that lovely Oklahoma soil. The starter course includes coops and rolltops sized perfectly for your green horse's first outing. The courses were built and designed by John Staples to encourage a forward, rhythmical ride. Cynthia Wiseman is a United States Eventing Association Certified Instructor and has competed through the CCI\* level of eventing. She will teach you the 4 Phases of Cross-Country riding and help you learn to ride in balance over terrain and fences.

### Requirements:

- All riders must wear an approved Safety Vest and a Medical Armband while schooling.
- Medical Armbands are available through USEA or through various online tack stores.
- An ASTM/SEI certified helmet is required at all times while mounted.
- Signed Stone Ridge Eventing Liability Release & Feather Creek Farm Liability Release

### Fees:

- Payable to Feather Creek Farm
  - o \$40 per horse for 1 day or \$70 per horse for 2 days.
  - o \$25 per night for stabling
- Payable to Cynthia Wiseman
  - o \$20 per horse per day for instruction/coaching
- Each rider is responsible for her own travel expenses.

**Stone Ridge Eventing Liability Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement**

**UNDER MISSOURI LAW, AND EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISK OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO THE REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI.**

For consideration received, and in return for the use, day and on all future dates of the property, facilities and services of STONE RIDGE, HEATH AND CYNTHIA WISEMAN, Rider, his or her heirs, assigns, and representatives hereby agrees as follows:**

1. **INHERENT RISKS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS.** Rider acknowledges the inherent risks of accidents and injuries to person an property in all horse-related activities and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to, the propensity of equine to behave in unpredictable ways such as running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of an equine’s reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and sub surface conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to control over the animal or not acting within such participant’s ability. Rider assumes all risk in connection with participation in any and all horse related activities for Rider and any family member or other person accompanying Rider, and expressly waives any claims for an injury or loss arising there from. Rider agrees to abide by and follow STONE RIDGE/CYNTHIA WISEMAN rules and regulations, which are available upon request. Rider further acknowledges that the behavior of any animal is contingent to some extent upon the ability of Rider. Fair disclosure of Rider’s abilities has been made to STONE RIDGE/CYNTHIA WISEMAN.
2. **DISCLOSURE OF ABILITIES.** Rider has made full and fair disclosure to Rider’s abilities and other information that may be on Rider’s ability to engage in any horse related activities.
3. **INDEMNIFICATION, RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS.** Rider agrees to indemnify, hold harmless to defend STONE RIDGE/CYNTHIA WISEMAN and any of their members, managers, owners, officers, employees and/or agents from and against, any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, judgment, orders, costs or expenses, including attorney’s fees, known or unknown which may in any way arise from or be in any way connected with Rider’s use of or services the property or equines of STONE RIDGE/CYNTHIA WISEMAN, including but not limited to, loss or damage of any equipment or personal property, personal or body injury or death, or illness to Rider, to any horse owned by Rider, and to any family member or other person accompanying Rider on the premises of STONE RIDGE (5526 Hwy M, Miller, MO) and or participating in any equine activities sponsored by and/or related to STONE RIDGE/CYNTHIA WISEMAN.
4. **WAIVER.** Rider agrees to waive the protection of any applicable statues in this jurisdiction whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at all time of executing said release.
